CONDITIONS:

If you are selected to participate in the Erasmus+ program as an exchange student, you will receive a grant that assures the payment of the living costs in Germany (850,00€/ month). Each selected participant will also get a travel

contribution of 820,00€. The winter term 2024/25 starts on **September 23**rd, **2024 and ends on February 21**st, **2025.** It is expected of all students to arrive at least a week before the start of the term.

APPLICATION:

If you wish to participate in the Erasmus+ exchange, first you need to apply directly at the UENR International

Relations Office: <u>iro@uenr.edu.gh</u> In case you are selected and pre-nominated by your home university, you will receive further information about the application process from HNEE. Make sure you apply with the following documents:

- O Motivational letter for the chosen study programme
- O Current enrolment certificate
- O Transcript of records

An application only has a chance to be successful if all documents are submitted together and completed in full. All language certificates must comply with the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). Otherwise, your application cannot be taken into consideration.

^{*}Some modules are taught in German. To choose those modules, a German C1 level is required.

NB: Only students who have completed one year taught course can apply.
